



Message from the President

Why another Christian college or another college at all, for that matter? The answer, quite simply, is to offer a unique perspective and program. There is a crisis in higher education today – even in “Christian” higher education. The crisis is theological and ethical. Secular institutions (and this includes a very large number which began as Christian entities) have rejected, openly or by disregard, the absolute truth of the Bible and the sovereign Lordship of Christ Jesus. Secular academia often delights in turning the children against the faith received from Christian homes. Most see Western Christian culture as an embarrassment and the antithesis of goodness, modernity, and progress.

In the religious sphere, the situation is not much better despite the valiant efforts of a handful of faithful institutions, which carry the banner for their own groups or denominations. Many “Christian” colleges pay homage to the Bible, but operate contrary to its directives, by maintaining a strict separation between biblical teaching and so-called “secular” disciplines. They may talk of a Christian worldview, but they fail to define such a perspective in terms of the only reliable standard – the Word of God. Or, they promote education, which is opposed to the development of a unified biblical perspective.

Furthermore, there is presently a dearth of educational institutions strongly committed to the Reformed Faith in all of its implications. The doctrines of God’s sovereign grace in all of their fullness have long been neglected as the foundational and fundamental components of true knowledge and wisdom. Christ College offers an alternative to this environment. Our goal is to offer a consistently Reformed alternative to secular humanism, Christian surrender, functional ignorance, and ethical chaos which form the context of so much of modern “education.” Christ College has many distinctive elements due to its thoroughgoing Calvinism and the consistent teaching of a biblical worldview. We are committed to the Pauline mission: “For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ” (II Corinthians 10:4-5).

Many people enroll in college specifically to enhance their prospect of securing suitable employment or higher education. However, the prime objective of Christ College is life preparation. That is, our goal is to give our graduates a solid foundation in the Christian Faith and its application to all of life. We seek to be The Biblical Worldview College in America. We trust you will see our vision for higher education and that you will recognize the beauty of our distinctives. Since only the Lord Jesus Christ and His Word are the beginning of wisdom, then we know you will agree that Christ College is a school to seriously consider.

1. IF YOU ATTEND A SCHOOL, PUBLIC OR PRIVATE, PLEASE HAVE AN **OFFICIAL GRADE TRANSCRIPT** SENT TO CHRIST COLLEGE. If you were home-schooled, please send available test scores, list work completed, and provide any other relevant information. Provide documentation of high school level studies completed in preparation for college. Christ College will not offer any remedial education course work and all students must be sufficiently prepared to benefit from college level education. Home school students may submit transcripts or summaries of high school course work that have been produced by their parents. A certified transcript from any institutional school attended should also be submitted where applicable. The transcripts should minimally include subjects studied, time frame in which the work has been or will be completed, and grade assigned. It is recommended that a minimum of 18 high school level courses be completed.
2. PROVIDE THREE LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION: One must come from your parent or guardian, another from your pastor or another leader in your church, and the last from a teacher (if you are not home-schooled) or another adult who knows you well. If you have been employed, your supervising employer may provide the third letter. Those writing the letters of recommendation should comment on how your abilities and aspirations fit with the overall mission of Christ College. These letters should be returned separately from your pre-admissions information packet and addressed to Admissions Review Committee, Christ College, 1420 Rock Springs Road, Buford, Georgia 30519.
3. Please include a recent photograph.
4. Please include a \$25 check or money order.
5. A Personal Interview may be required prior to admission. Prospective students will be contacted if this is required by the admissions review committee.
